

## About the Visitation to the hospitalized patients

Due to the transition to stage 5 of new coronavirus infection, the following measures will be taken from **8<sup>th</sup> May (Mon)** to prevent nosocomial infection.

※Please note that the following information is subject to change at short notice depending on the future spread of infection.

- When you come to the hospital, we would like to check your body condition.
- Before going to ward, please report to the reception desk on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor.
- Please refrain from eating and drinking during the visit.

### <Maternity ward · MFICU>

- Meeting Time : From 1p.m. to 8p.m.
- When you come to pick up at discharge, please wait at waiting room on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor.
- Meeting only at the hospital room.  
※It is not possible to visit the outpatient floor on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor or use shared parts such as salons.

### <Delivery room>

- If you wish to have a witnessed delivery, **please check the hospital website in advance**

### <NICU/GCU>

- **Please consult with staffs.**

### **For visitors, please make sure the following in advance.**

(For inpatients, please call us for consultation if you have following symptoms.)

- Please measure your body temperature in advance.
- Please do not come to our hospital when you have a symptom of cold  
(For example, a fever, cough, or sore throat).
- If you are concerned about your body condition, please stay at home.
- When you visit our hospital, you must wear a mask and please use the hand sanitizer.
